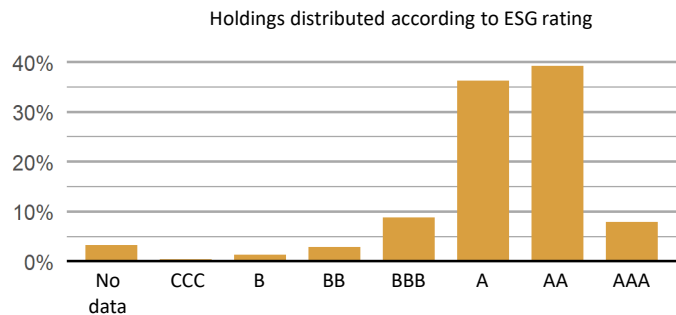

ESG RATING



The ESG rating measures the resilience of the fund companies to environment, social and governance risks. The size of the risks assumed by the companies as well as their risk-handling ability are measured. The ESG rating is allocated to the individual company on the basis of general and sector-specific conditions. The least resilient company in a sector will be allocated a CCC rating and the most resilient company will be allocated a AAA rating.

Tonnes CO₂ emission in relation to USD 1 million invested in the companies' shares or corporate bonds¹

A DKK 100,000 investment in the fund's shares and corporate bonds corresponds to the CO₂ emission of²:

The companies' total emission of greenhouse gases has been converted into CO₂ units and distributed on all owners of shares and corporate bonds. CO₂ data is available for 86% of the fund's holdings of shares and corporate bonds.
